

No Mow May

Cold Aston Parish Council has been asked by a parishioner to consider implementing No Mow May in 2022.

Currently the Parish Council supports biodiversity in the village through leaving the verges on the roads in and out the village long with just one cut after the wildflowers have died back. In addition we have three wildflower verges on the edge of the village, outside The Old Vicarage, Spring Cottage and Elm Bank Barn.

The “No Mow” request would extend this to the maintained verges in the centre of the village. We recognise that there will be strong feelings either way with regard to this request and therefore are putting it out to consultation.
